The 123rd Annual Maryland State Shoot will be held at our home grounds in Thurmont. The Maryland State Sportsmen's Association will have full responsibility for conducting this shoot.

The Maryland State Sportsmen's Association is not responsible for accidents or injuries on the State Association's grounds and/or the gun club grounds.

All 2024 ATA and Maryland State Sportsmen's Association rules and regulations will be enforced and will govern all points not otherwise provided for herein. The Officer or Officers of the Maryland State Sportsmen's Association present at this shoot will make all decisions pertaining to the shoot, and his, her, or their decisions will be binding.

Change of Program

The Maryland State Sportsmen's Association reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry, and/or to change the program or plan of shooting in case weather, attendance, or other factors make it advisable.

This shoot will be under the direct supervision of the Officers of the Maryland State Sportsmen's Association.

Classification and Handicapping

The 2022 through 2024 averages and the last 1000 targets registered in each category will be used, plus known ability, which includes nonregistered shooting and past performances. Those shooters who do not have ATA cards, or do not have their ATA cards up-to-date, will be assigned Class and/or Yardage at the Committee's discretion.

IT IS THE SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT HIS ATA CARD IS CORRECT AND UP-TO-DATE. ERRONEOUS CARDS SUBMITTED WILL RESULT IN DISBARMENT, FORFEITURE OF ALL TROPHIES AND MONIES, AND WILL BE REPORTED TO THE ATA FOR FURTHER DISCIPLINE.

SHOOTER'S INFORMATION - CONTINUED

50 TARGETS PER TRAP

Each bank will consist of two traps and 50 targets will be shot on each trap.

Advanced squadding will only be permitted for a limited number of squads based on last year's attendance. All advanced squadding will be done after 12 p.m. each day for future events.

STARTING TIMES EACH DAY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED

ENTRIES/CLASSIFICATION

It is the shooter's responsibility to see that the correct Class and/or Yardage, as well as any Special Category eligibility, are plainly marked on his/her cashier's receipt.

Any contestant shooting in a Class or from a Yardage other than that assigned to him or her shall be disqualified and shall forfeit all rights to any trophies, purses, or monies involved.

TROPHIES

Trophies cannot be shipped. Trophies will be presented after the shootoffs each day and at other times as posted on the scoreboard and in the clubhouse. Any trophies not picked up by the end of the last day of the shoot will become the property of MSSA.

No shooter may win more than one trophy in any event.

GOLF CARTS

Golf carts, ATVs and similar vehicles may not be used on the premises until they are registered with MSSA. A registration sticker will be issued when proof of insurance is shown to Carville Evering. The sticker is valid for all shoots as long as the insurance is valid.

Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate motor bikes, golf carts, ATVs, or other motor vehicles on MSSA premises.

NOTE: Targets shot through June 26th, 2024, may be counted toward target requirements.

SINGLES

Shooters with less than 500 registered 16 yard targets on their average card for 2024 which have been shot between Sept. 1, 2023 thru June 26, 2024, and a total of less than 1500 registered 16 yard targets for the current year and the previous 2 years combined, shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.

HANDICAP

Shooters with less than 500 registered handicap targets on their average card for 2024 which have been shot between Sept. 1, 2023 thru June 26, 2024 and a total of less than 1500 registered handicap targets for the current year and previous 2 years combined, shall be penalized as follows:

Adult male shooters and Juniors will be assigned 2 yards in addition to their normal yardage, subject to a 23 yard minimum and a 25 yard maximum. Ladies, Sub-Juniors and Veterans will follow the same rule except the minimum penalty will be 21 yards. Ladies, Juniors, Sub-Juniors, and Veterans, may elect to shoot for "Targets Only", and be exempt from penalty yardage, but will not be eligible for any trophies or added money and may not play any option monies. There will be no penalty yardage assigned to Senior Veterans.

DOUBLES

Shooters with less than 500 registered doubles targets on their average card for 2024 which have been shot between Sept. 1, 2023 thru June 26, 2024, and a total of less than 1000 registered doubles targets for the current year and the previous 2 years combined, shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.

NOTE: Should you win or tie for any Class or High Gun trophy in any 16 yard or Doubles event, it shall be your duty to report to the classification committee and move up one class. Class advances will not be applied on preliminary Wednesday.

SHOOTOFFS

All ties will be shot off at shoot management's discretion. Notice of any decision to carry over any shootoffs will be made by announcement, and will be posted on the scoreboard, at the close of the last event of the day. Any contestant leaving the grounds before a shootoff, or failing to answer the shootoff call, forfeits all rights to any trophies involved.

ATTENTION ALL SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

It is very important for you to remember the ATA Rules regarding your responsibility for declaring your special category eligibility.

When you are **CLASSIFIED** - you must tell the Classification Committee member handling your card whether or not you are eligible for any special category, and check your Classification receipt to be certain that it shows your correct eligibility.

Remember the ATA rule change regarding special categories. A shooter can declare only one special category - not two (Lady - not Lady/Vet or Junior - not Lady/Junior, etc.).

If a special category shooter ties for champion in any event and loses in the shoot off, he or she automatically falls back to the special category trophy.

You will **NOT** be eligible for any special category trophies if your Classification does not include that information.

CLOSING TIMES

The Closing Times listed are the times the cashier window closes for that Event. If your entry is not paid prior to the closing time, you will not be able to enter the event.

MAKE-UP TARGETS

No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets on the practice trap if he/she has missed his or her squad. If the shooter is unable to join the squad before they have started their 3rd sub event, the shooter must be resquadded.

SHOOTERS CAUTION

A shooter can make only one entry per event. Once the entry has been made, the cashier will not accept additional option monies from the shooter. **POSITIVELY NO CHANGES, WITHDRAWALS, OR REFUNDS** will be allowed once the entry has been made.

SHOOTERS ARE CAUTIONED TO CHECK THEIR SCORES as soon as they finish shooting and the scores have been posted.

The management will not be responsible for any errors after the options have been figured and posted on the board.

CAMPING INFORMATION

MSSA offers 38 camping sites with water and 50-amp electric service at \$30.00 per night or a 5-year lease at \$1,000.00 payable in advance to MSSA. All camping spots need to be reserved.

A dump station is on site. Pump out services are available at the State Shoot only for a fee determined by the septic service company.
