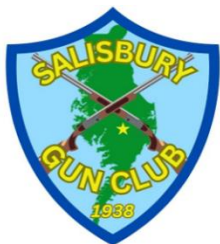

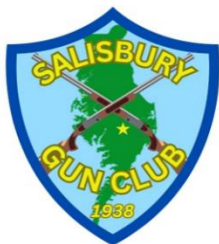

All Contestants Please Read Carefully

The 125th Annual Maryland State Shoot will be held at our Home Grounds in Thurmont. The Maryland State Sportsmen's Association (MSSA) will have full responsibility for conducting this shoot.

The MSSA is not responsible for accidents or injuries on the State Association's Grounds and/or the gun club grounds.

All 2026 ATA and MSSA rules and regulations will be enforced and will govern all points not otherwise provided for herein. The Officer or Officers of the MSSA present at this shoot will make all decisions pertaining to the shoot, and their decisions will be binding.

All-American Point Days

Wednesday through Sunday are eligible for All-American points, as governed by ATA rules.

Camping

MSSA offers 38 camping sites with water and 50-amp electric service at \$30 per night or a 5-year lease at \$1000, payable in advance to MSSA. All camping spots need to be reserved.

A dump station is on site. Pump out services are available at the State Shoot only for a fee determined by the septic service company.

Contact Ray Greb to reserve your camping site. Payment is due in advance and must be received no later than May 15th or the site will be released. **Make checks payable to MSSA.** Mailing address:

As a lease holder, you are required to notify MSSA by May 15th if you will be using the site for the State Shoot. If no notification is received, MSSA has the right to rent your site, if needed.

Campsites are event use only. Sites are available 24 hours prior to and 24 hours after all events.

Change of Program

The MSSA reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry, and/or to change the program or plan of shooting in case of weather, attendance, or other factors make it advisable.

This shoot will be under the direct supervision of the Officers of the MSSA.

Classification and Handicapping

The 2024 through 2026 averages and the last 1000 targets registered in each category will be used, plus known ability, which includes nonregistered shooting and past performances. Those shooters who do not have ATA cards, or do not have their ATA cards up to date, will be assigned Class and/or Yardage at the Committee's discretion.

IT IS THE SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT HIS ATA CARD IS CORRECT AND UP TO DATE. ERRONEOUS CARDS SUBMITTED WILL RESULT IN THE DISBARMENT, FORFEITURE OF ALL TROPHIES AND MONIES, AND WILL BE REPORTED TO THE ATA FOR FURTHER DISCIPLINE.

It is the shooter's responsibility to see that the correct class and/or yardage, as well as any special category eligibility, are plainly marked on their cashier's receipt.

Any contestant shooting in a class or from a yardage other than that assigned to him or her shall be disqualified and shall forfeit all rights to any trophies, purses, or monies involved.

NOTE: Targets shot through June 24th, 2026, may be counted toward target requirements.

SINGLES: Shooters must have at least 500 registered 16-yard targets on their average card for 2026 which have been shot between Sept. 1, 2025 through June 24, 2026. Additionally, they must have at minimum, 1500 registered 16-yard targets for the current year and previous two years combined. Else, they shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.

HANDICAP: Shooters must have at least 500 registered handicap targets on their average card for 2026 (which have been shot between Sept. 1, 2025 thru June 24, 2026) and at least 1500 registered handicap targets for the current year and previous 2 years combined. Else, they shall be penalized as follows:

Adult shooters, Juniors, Junior Golds, and Sub-Vet's will be assigned 2 yards in addition to their normal yardage, subject to a 23-yard minimum and a 25-yard maximum.

Ladies, Sub-Juniors and Veterans will follow the same rule except the minimum penalty will be 21-yards.

Ladies, Juniors, Sub-Juniors, and Veterans may elect to shoot for "Targets Only", and be exempt from penalty yardage, but will not be eligible for any trophies or added money and may not play any option monies.

There will be no penalty yardage assigned to Senior Veterans.

DOUBLES: Shooters must have at least 500 registered doubles targets on their average card for 2026 which have been shot between Sept. 1, 2025 through June 24, 2026. Additionally, they must have at minimum, 1500 registered doubles targets for the current year and previous two years combined. Else, they shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.

NOTE: High score in each class in any 16-yard or doubles event, it shall be your duty to report to the Classification Committee and move up one class. Class advances will not be applied on preliminary Wednesday.

Attention all special category shooters

It is very important for you to remember the ATA rules regarding your responsibility for declaring your special category eligibility.

When you are CLASSIFIED – you must tell the Classification Committee member handling your card if you are eligible for any special category and check your Classification receipt to be certain that it shows your correct eligibility.

Remember the ATA rules regarding special categories. A shooter can declare only one special category – not two (for example, Lady II – not Lady II/ Vet).

If a special category shooter ties for champion in any event and loses in the shoot off, they automatically fall back to the special category trophy. If a special category shooter wins or ties for their special category trophy, they are not eligible to fall to class or yardage group trophies.

You will NOT be eligible for any special category trophies if your Classification does not include that information.

Eligibility for the State Team at the Grand American is determined by the resident high scores in the Singles Championship.

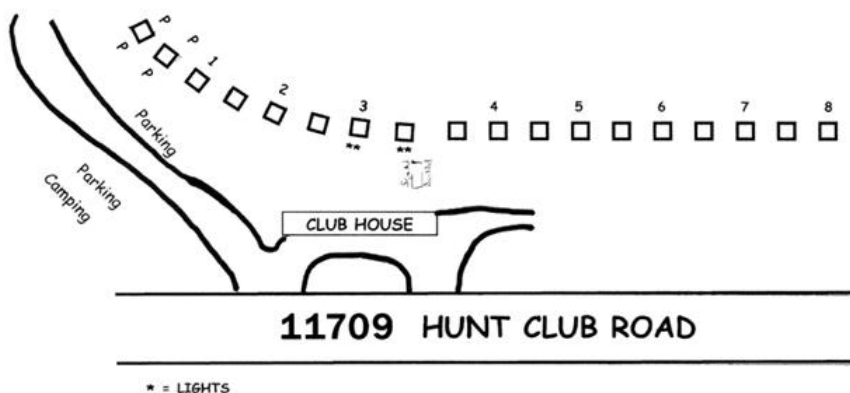
Golf Carts

Make-up Targets

No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets on the practice trap if they missed their squad. If the shooter is unable to join the squad before they have started their third sub event, the shooter must be re-squadded.

Modified Lewis

All purses listed in the program as "Modified Lewis" will be divided as follows:

50% of total purse will be paid to the top two scores, divided 60/40 percentage.

50% of total purse will be divided into two, three or four lewis classes, with one money each class. The third score will lead the first class.

Payouts

A \$30 re-issuing fee will be applied for all checks that must be reissued.

Daily payouts are available at the office after 12 noon. Sunday's payouts will be mailed.

Shoot Management

Each bank will consist of two traps and 50 targets will be shot on each trap.

Advanced squadding will only be permitted for a limited number of squads based on last year's attendance. All advanced squadding will be done after 12 p.m. each day for future events.

Management reserves the right to change squad or bank assignments to expedite the event.

Starting times each day will be strictly enforced.

Closing times are listed in the following program and will be strictly followed. If your entry is not paid prior to the closing time, you will not be able to enter the event.

Scores will be finalized one hour after the conclusion of the event.

The 200-target singles championship will be shot as two, 100 target sub-events, rolling through on each bank. Announcements will be made for a bench call and the squad-board will reflect when the second 100 is beginning.

Reduced Price Targets

Sub-Juniors, Juniors, and Junior Golds are eligible for reduced price targets if they do not play any options. They must make this election at classification and it cannot be changed through the entire tournament.

Shoot Offs

All ties will be shot off at shoot management's discretion. Notice of any decision to carry over any shoot offs will be made by announcement and will be posted on the scoreboard, at the close of the last event of the day. Any contestant leaving the grounds before a shoot off, or failing to answer the shoot off call, forfeits all rights to any trophies involved.

Shooters Caution

A shooter can make only one entry per event. Once the entry has been made, the cashier will not accept additional option monies from the shooter. POSITIVELY NO CHANGES OR WITHDRAWALS will be allowed once the entry has been made. Refunds will be made solely at shoot management's discretion.

Shooters are cautioned to check their scores as soon as they finish shooting, and the scores have been posted.

Management will not be responsible for any errors after the options have been figured and posted on the board.

State Association Meeting

A meeting of the MSSA will be held after the final event Saturday, immediately following the shoot offs. This is open to all Maryland ATA shooters. The meeting also includes the Hall of Fame induction.
